**Regular Scheduled Meeting**

The Board of Supervisor's of Liberty Township, of Adams County, met Tuesday, December 2, 2014 at 7:30pm at the Liberty Township Municipal Building, 39 Topper Road, Fairfield, PA 17320, for their regular scheduled meeting.

Present: John Bostek Chairman, Bob Jackson, LeeEsta Shaffer, Solicitor Davis and Chief Briggs. Marie Cochran did not attend.

**Supervisors' Remarks:** Mr. Bostek stated next month's meeting will be held on the first Monday, January 5, 2015.
