

**Liberty Township Board of Supervisors
39 Topper Road
Fairfield, PA 17320**

***Regular Monthly Meeting
February 3, 2015***

The Board of Supervisors of Liberty Township, of Adams County, met Monday, January 5, 2015 at 7:00pm at the Liberty Township Municipal Building, 39 Topper Road, Fairfield, PA 17320, for their Re-organization meeting.

Present: Mr. John Bostek, Mr. Bob Jackson, Mrs. Marie Cochran, Mrs. LeeEsta Shaffer, Chief Brand Briggs, and Mr. Walter Davis.

Supervisor Comments- Mr. Bostek stated a representative of the Wormald Development will be giving an update on the development project at the March 3rd Supervisor meeting at 7:30pm.

Minutes of the *January 5, 2015* meeting were read and were accepted with no objections.

Treasurer's Report was reviewed and accepted by the Supervisors.

Approval of bills: Mr. Jackson made a motion to pay the bills as stated, seconded by Mrs. Cochran and the motion passed unanimously.

Public Participation: Mr. Charles Alexander questioned why he cannot just change the lot lines on his subdivision without resubmission. Mrs. Shaffer explained any changes to his property lines will need to be resubmitted and follow the current subdivision ordinance, since his original property changes occurred prior to 200, and he did not file the changes with the county.

Mr. Swiat asked Solicitor Davis what the difference is between the secretary/treasurer's bond and a bank loan. Solicitor Davis stated the secretary bond's issuer would pay the township any losses up to its covered amount where and a loan is an instrument that the township would need to repay.

Solicitor – None.

Police Officer's Report – Chief Briggs read his report.

Zoning Officer's Report – Mr. Bostek read this report.

Roadmaster Report - Mr. Jackson read this report and stated the Road Crew have been plowing snow, replacing road signs, and repairing the many potholes.

Planning Commission Report – Mrs. Wenchhof stated there were no official plans submitted, however there were two (2) sketch plans discussed.

Old Business:

1310 Tract Road- Mrs. Jackson asks Solicitor Davis the status on his certified letter to Ms. Reed. Solicitor Davis responded he had received a signed receipt of acceptance that the letter had been received. He also stated the next step is to file a complaint with the courts to access fines. **Mr. Bostek made a motion to have Solicitor Davis file a criminal complaint against Ms. Reed at 1320 Tract Rd, Fairfield, PA, was seconded by Mr. Jackson and passed unanimously.**

New Business:

Resolution R1-2015 Hemp Cultivation- Mr. Bostek explained that hemp cultivation is currently band in Pennsylvania. The Association of Boroughs is petitioning the legislators to overturn this decision. Mr. Bostek also stated hemp does not contain the harmful THC. **A motion by Mr. Bostek to approve Resolution R1-2015 Hemp Cultivation Support and was seconded by Mr. Jackson and massed unanimously.**

With no further business, the meeting adjourned at 8:20p.m. on a motion by Mr. Bostek, seconded by Mr. Jackson Vote unanimous.
