***Regular Monthly Meeting
June 2, 2015***

The Board of Supervisors of Liberty Township, of Adams County, met Tuesday, June 2, 2015 at 7:30pm at the Liberty Township Municipal Building, 39 Topper Road, Fairfield, PA 17320, for their Regular meeting.

Present: Mr. John Bostek, Mrs. Marie Cochran, Mr. Bob Jackson, Mrs. LeeEsta Shaffer, Secretary, Chief Brand Briggs and Mr. Walter Davis Solicitor.

Supervisor Comments- None.

Minutes of the *May 5, 2015* meeting were read and were accepted on a motion by Mr. Bostek and seconded by Mr. Jackson and passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report was reviewed and accepted by the Supervisors.

Approval of bills: Mr. Jackson made a motion to pay the bills as stated, seconded by Mr. Bostek and the motion passed unanimously.

Public Participation:

Mr. Swiat complimented the Roads Department on cleaning the intersection of Tract, Wenschhof and Crum Roads.

Mr. Hogan asked if the new building be kept maintained. The Board assured him it will be.

Police Officer's Report – Chief Briggs read his report.

Roadmaster Report – Mr. Jackson read this report.

Planning Commission Report – Mrs. Wenschhof stated there was no quorum for the meeting however they do recommend approval of both the Taylor and Alexander plans. Mrs. Wenschhof asked the board if Mr. Brad Rigler will be retaining his position on the commission, Mr. Jackson state he would check into it.

Old Business:

Resident Mark Brown submitted a 90 day extension on his subdivision-A Motion by Mr. Jackson to grant the 90 day extension was seconded by Mrs. Cochran and passed unanimously.

Harrington & Sons-Mr. Harrington has requested a 30day extension to clean up the property on State Route 16. A motion to grant Mr. Harrington a 30day extension by Mrs. Cochran was seconded by Mr. Jackson and passed unanimously.

Henry Taylor Subdivision plan was approved on a Motion by Mrs. Cochran and was seconded by Mr. Jackson and passed unanimously.

Township Salt Shed was discussed. Mr. Bostek asks Solicitor Davis what we need to do since the shed cover with an attached truck bay will be encroaching on the property set back line. Solicitor Davis stated the Township will need to apply to the Zoning Hearing Board for approval before advertising.

New Business:

Land and Sea-A motion by Mr. Bostek to appoint Land and Sea as the Code Enforcement Officers was seconded by Mr. Jackson and passed unanimously.

With no further business, the meeting adjourned at 8:24p.m. on a motion by Mr. Bostek, seconded by Mrs. Cochran. Vote unanimous.
