July 7, 2015***

The Board of Supervisors of Liberty Township, of Adams County, met Tuesday, July 7, 2015 at 7:30pm at the Liberty Township Municipal Building, 39 Topper Road, Fairfield, PA 17320, for their Regular meeting.
