***Regular Monthly Meeting  
August 4, 2015***

The Board of Supervisors of Liberty Township, of Adams County, met Tuesday, August 4, 2015 at 7:30pm at the Liberty Township Municipal Building, 39 Topper Road, Fairfield, PA 17320, for their Regular meeting.

Present: Mr. John Bostek, Mr. Bob Jackson, Mrs. LeeEsta Shaffer, Secretary and Solicitor Walter Davis. Mrs. Marie Cochran, Chief Brand Briggs, and Assistant Solicitor, John Phillips did not attend.

**Supervisor Comments-**Chairman Bostek stated a zoning hearing was held on the 28<sup>th</sup> of July 2015 requesting exemption on the property setback requirements. The Zoning Board unanimously approved the requests. He also asked Mr. Barlow of the Road Crew if resident complaints on Orchard and Boyle Roads have been taken care of, Mr. Barlow stated they have.

Mr. Jackson stated he would be asking Fairfield and Fountaindale Fire Companies to help clean out some of the Townships clogged pipes. He also stated tar and chipping of Pecher, Liberty Hall and Girl Scout Roads will begin within the next several weeks. He assured residents that signs will be posted letting them know when this will take place.

Minutes of the *July 7, 2015* meeting were read and were accepted on a motion by Mr. Jackson and Mr. Bostek seconded by and passed unanimously.

**Treasurer's Report** was reviewed and accepted by the Supervisors.

**Approval of bills:** Mr. Jackson made a motion to pay the bills as stated, seconded by Mr. Bostek and the motion passed unanimously.

**Solicitor** – None.

**Police Officer's Report** – None.

**Zoning Officer's Report** – Mr. Bostek read this report.

**Roadmaster Report** – Mr. Jackson stated he would like to be ready to advertise the salt shed bid as soon as possible and asks Mr. Davis if the board could authorize Mrs. Shaffer to advertise the bid after the Planning Commission vote. Mr. Davis stated a motion to authorize, pending the Planning Commission vote is acceptable. **Mr. Bostek made a motion to authorize Mrs. Shaffer to advertise the salt shed project pending Planning Commission approval with a bid opening on September 15, 2015 at 9a.m. The bid will be awarded in a separate meeting on September 17, 2015 at 9a.m., was seconded by Mr. Jackson and passed unanimously.**

**Planning Commission Report** – Mrs. Shaffer stated no meeting was held.

**Old Business:**

Mark Brown subdivision, 90day extension request- Mr. Lee Royer engineer for Mr. Brown submitted a 90 day extension request. Mr. Brown has filed an application for a zoning hearing to which the outcome will determine the continuance or withdraw of his subdivision plans.

**New Business:**

Resignation- Mr. Brad Rigler, member of the Planning Commission rendered his resignation to the Supervisors effective immediately due to relocating for employment. Mr. Bostek motioned to accept Mr. Rigler's resignation and Mr. Jackson seconded. Motion passed unanimously. Mr. Bostek thanked Mr. Rigler for his service and wishes him well.

With no further business, the meeting adjourned at 8:06p.m. on a motion by Mr. Bostek, seconded by Mr. Jackson. Vote unanimous.
