ORDINANCE NO. 01 of 2017

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RE^ESTABLISHING THE LIBERTY TOWNSHIP
POLICE RETIREMENT PLAN**

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors in and for the Township of Liberty, Adams County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION I: ESTABLISHMENT.

This Ordinance amends and reestablishes the retirement plan for the police employees of Liberty Township by adopting the Liberty Township Police Retirement Plan document restated January 1, 2013.


SECTION II: REPEALER

This Ordinance specifically replaces all other ordinances or parts of ordinances establishing provisions for a police retirement plan, and any ordinance or parts thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby expressly repealed.




SECTION III: SAVINGS PROVISION

In the event that any provision, section, sentence, clause, or part of this Liberty Township Police Retirement Plan is held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provision, section, sentence, clause, or part of the Liberty Township Police Retirement Plan, it being the intent of the Township that such remainder shall be remain in full force and effect.


